Overview of Tool

This is a representative model of how Professional Learning is embedded in our school culture. Professional Learning happens during grade level meetings, grade managers' meetings, large group conversations, small group conversations, etc. e of at least the terms we use for when certain groups meet during the month/year.

How Should a Leader Use This Tool?

There are certain times that we want to make sure staff members know where to be and what to plan to discuss, so we developed this graphic organizer so they would know how to structure their time. We print this at the beginning of every year so that the terms we use for different "groups" will have more relevance and will become more familiar to them.
